Gallup's latest Values and Beliefs update conducted last month shows that 92% of Americans say married men and women having an affair is morally wrong, garnering more disgrace than any other moral issue tested in the poll.

Some of the other issues considered morally wrong by those polled were: polygamy (91%); cloning (88%); abortion (56%); gay or lesbian relations (47%); having a baby outside of marriage (45%); sex between an unmarried man and woman (40%); embryonic stem cell research (36%); divorce and death penalty, both at 30%."
