## **Summit On Hold for Dorms**

Just as we were ready to sign for the dorms, we were informed of the following decision from the Miami County Economic Development Authority (MCEDA).

This means that the decision on the dorms will be postponed for awhile. We are not disheartened. If God does not choose for us to become a Resident School, we accept His will. Over \$50,000.00 of unsolicited money has been sent in for the renovation. May God's will be done. Fortunately, we have not spent any money in preparation for the change to a Resident School. The following note will fill you in on the status to date.

## George,

Reference our telephone conversation today regarding the delay in acquiring two of the dormitories at Grissom for your expansion project. I thought I would follow-up with an email explanation as well.

As we discussed on the phone, the Miami County Economic Development Authority has very recently received an inquiry into the acquisition of the entire Dormitory Area (approximately 23 acres) for use as a training center. As I explained on the phone, my Board would like to further explore this possibility before executing your Purchase Agreement and, if possible, further explore the feasibility of both developments occurring or co-existing on the same "campus".

Our Board apologizes for any inconvenience or delay this may cause and would ask for your indulgence for the next 60 days while we evaluate this new inquiry. Please do not hesitate to call or email with any questions or just to check-in.
